Membership Details

- Each member must commit to donating \$100 per meeting (\$400 per year)
- Members will have an opportunity to recommit annually
- The donations will be given to a 501(c)3 non-profit organization serving our community
- The purpose for the contribution is to stay 100% local. Therefore, charities benefitting a broader national audience will not be considered. Organizations chartered nationally can be considered, if the funds will be used locally

What the quarterly events will look like

- Social/networking opportunity: 45 minutes
 - Drinks and appetizers provided
 - Members will sign in and receive a nominating ballot and a voting ballot
 - Members can (but aren't required to) nominate a local 501(c)3 nonprofit organization or community need for consideration
- Meeting: 45 minutes
 - Previous organization/charity recipient will be invited to share the impact of our donation
 - We plan to recognize members for any recent accomplishments or positive impact in the Tri-State community
 - Rules will be briefly explained to new members
 - Three of the nominated charities will be randomly drawn for the opportunity to present
 - Each of the three nominators will get 2-4 minutes to make a short presentation explaining why we should support this local cause, organization, or charity
 - Members who are present will vote on which one of the three causes most deserves our support
 - Votes will be tallied. Majority rules
- Donation Information
 - Members can make their donations online
 - Those who have not already made their donation online will make out a \$100 check to Resources Unite during the event, and those checks will be collected by the board members before the event concludes
 - If you are unable to attend the meeting, please donate online. As a last resort, you can send your check to Resources Unite with "100+ Men" in the memo
 - Two weeks after each meeting, all members will be invited to deliver the "Big Check" to the recipient
